

Please note: The above chart illustrates the percentage of **incidents** not individuals involved in incidents. Multiple students may be involved in one incident.







Suspensions – 2012-2013

Six male students and one female student were suspended for the following types of circumstances (five of the students had student conduct history):

- Altercation (one student)
- Damage to property and dangerous behavior (one student)
- Driving under the influence of alcohol (one student)
- Sexual misconduct (one student)
- Significant possession of drugs (one student)
- Possession of alcohol and drugs while on University Probation (two students)

Expulsions - 2012 - 2013

Eighteen male students and one female student were expelled for the following types of circumstances (Ten of the students had student conduct history):

- Assault (one student)
- Driving under the influence of alcohol and striking a pedestrian (two students)
- Drug distribution (twelve students)
- Possession of drugs while on University Probation (one student)
- Sexual misconduct (two students)
- Major theft (one student)

University Probation

111 students appeared before the Probation Review Committee in 2012-2013. 106 students (95%) were successful and their University Probations were lifted. 5 students were denied (5%).
